


Ellicottville

With year-round outdoor recreation opportunities, the comfortable charm of a close-knit community and scenic beauty for as far as the eye can see, Ellicottville is one of Western New York's most desirable destinations in which to live, work, and visit. Entrepreneurs who operate in the region are extremely optimistic about Ellicottville's economic forecast. While Ellicottville has served as one of Timberbuilt's prime building locations for more than twenty years, the company has continued to expand its

market across the country and into Canada. Their connection with the Southern Tier community promises to remain strong thanks to Timberbuilt's latest Ellicottville project, Sommerville Valley. Set on eightyfive acres outside of the village, Sommerville Valley is a community of five-acre building lots featuring timber homes strategically nestled within sixty acres of common wildlife area to be used for skiing, hiking, snowshoeing, mountain biking, and other outdoor winter activities. Seneca Allegany Resort and Casino is located approximately twenty minutes away from the heart of Ellicottville. The facility has expanded over the years, giving visitors to the region the opportunity to enhance their trip to the area by visiting nearby Salamanca for a very intimate experience that offers superior customer service and excellent entertainment options in a beautiful and quiet setting. The twenty-four-hour casino has more than three million visitors each year who are attracted to a rich diversity of fine-dining options, luxurious award-winning hotel rooms, a full-service salon and spa, wellrenowned world-class entertainment, 2,000 of the latest slot machines, and

over thirty action-packed table games. The favorable economic conditions for a region that continues to thrive makes Ellicottville highly desirable for entrepreneurs. "The local residents appreciate, respect and continually support the many different businesses in Ellicottville," says Eshbaugh. "Their existence is one of the main reasons why they live here. The unique stores, award-winning restaurants, and the many festivals and social activities that take place throughout the year keep the yearround residents here and bring thousands of visitors to our community." Labeling Ellicottville as a home away from home is an understatement for many of the repeat visitors. "The people are really genuine here and that definitely attracts people to Ellicottville," says Eshbaugh. "There really is no other place like it and that is what causes first-time visitors to return year after year.' The community as a whole has a shared philosophy and vision for their region. Because most of the existing small business owners understand their success will help contribute to improved marketing of Ellicottville, they promote one another and highlight the many year-round

recreation opportunities that are available to residents and visitors. "There are so many fun things to do here," says Eshbaugh. "Most everyone knows we are a four-season community and just a tremendous place to come and relax. The visitors who we are constantly welcoming make every day of work fun, interesting, and enjoyable. When you look at all of the recreational activities that are offered, especially now in the winter months, it really is not hard to see why Ellicottville is a truly awesome place to live, work, and play."
